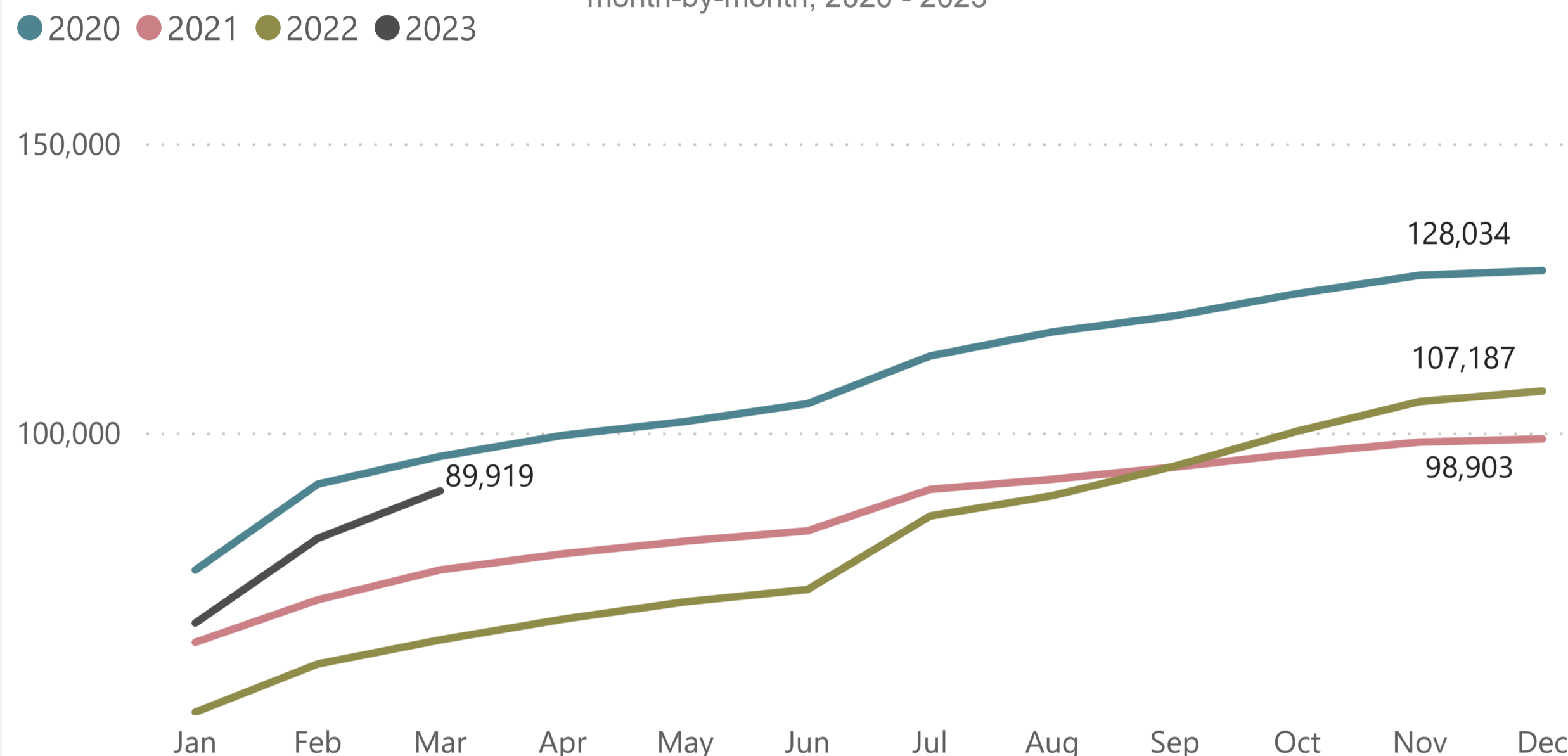

month-by-month, 2020 - 2023

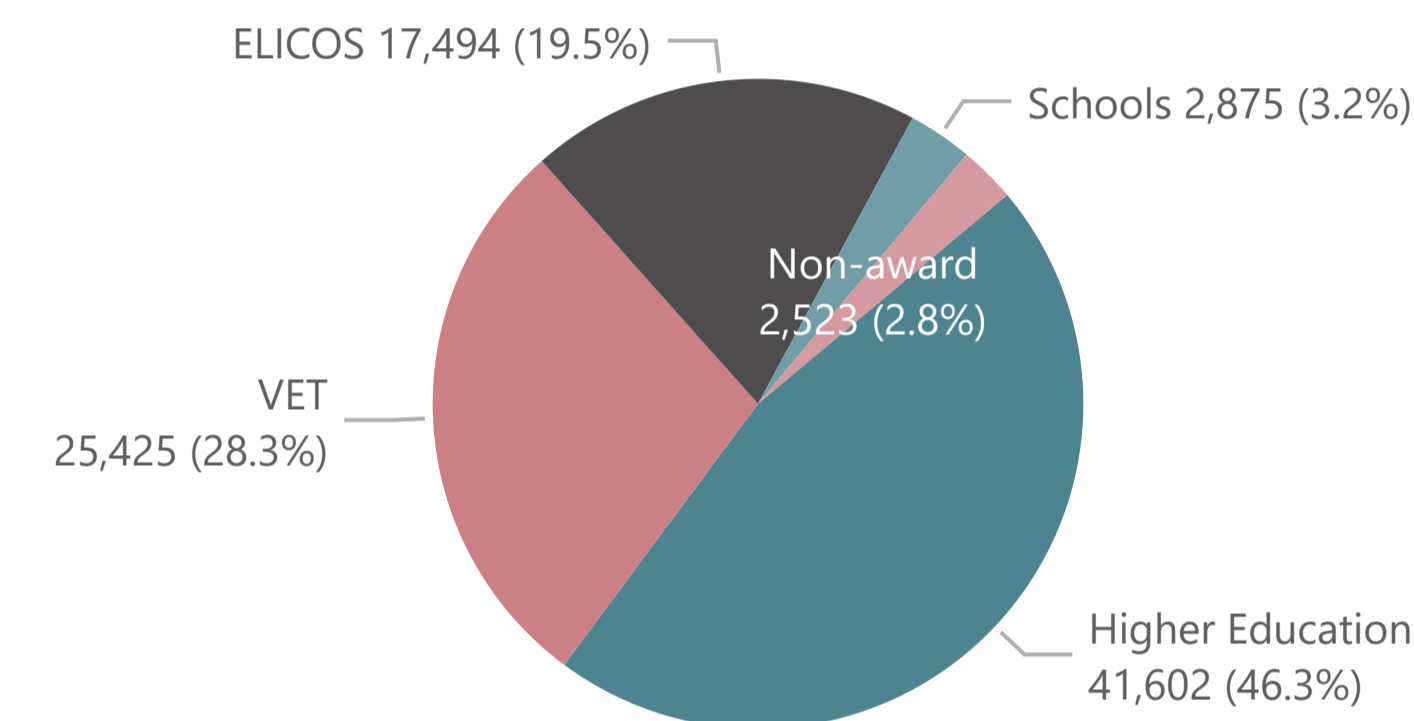

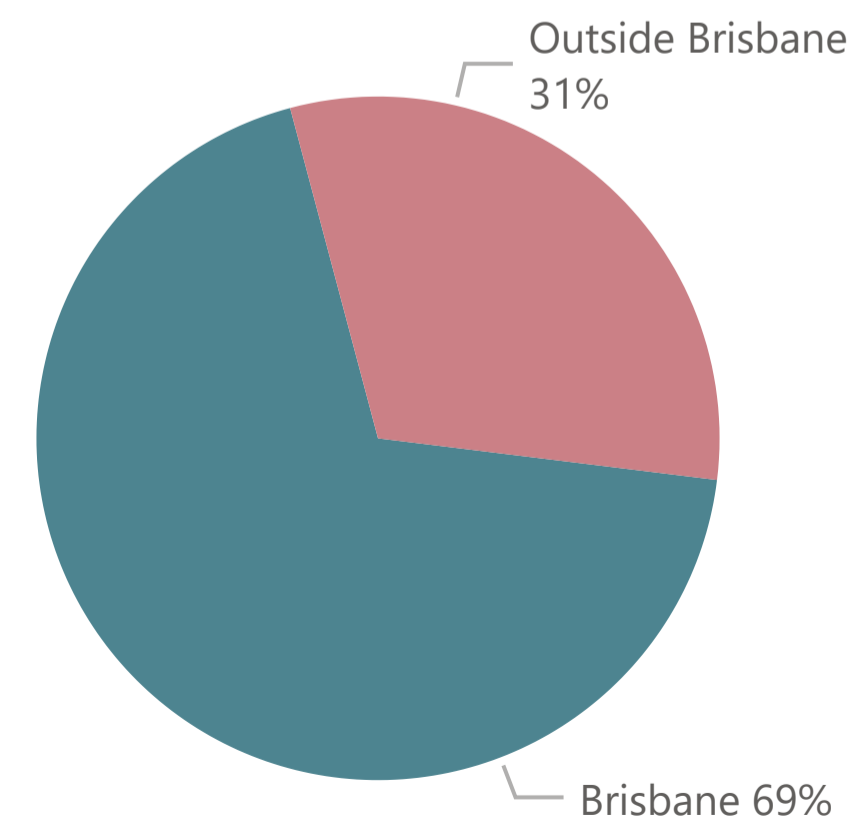

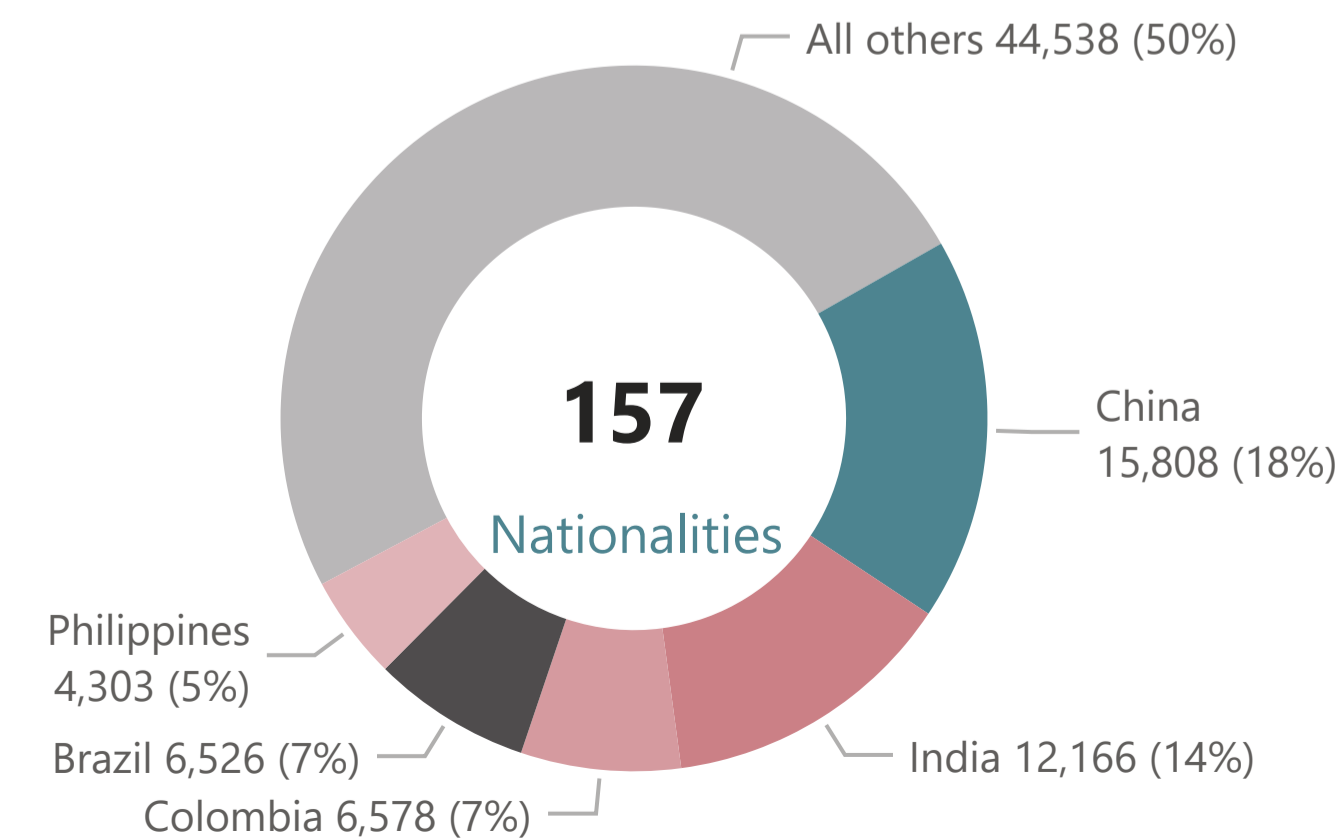

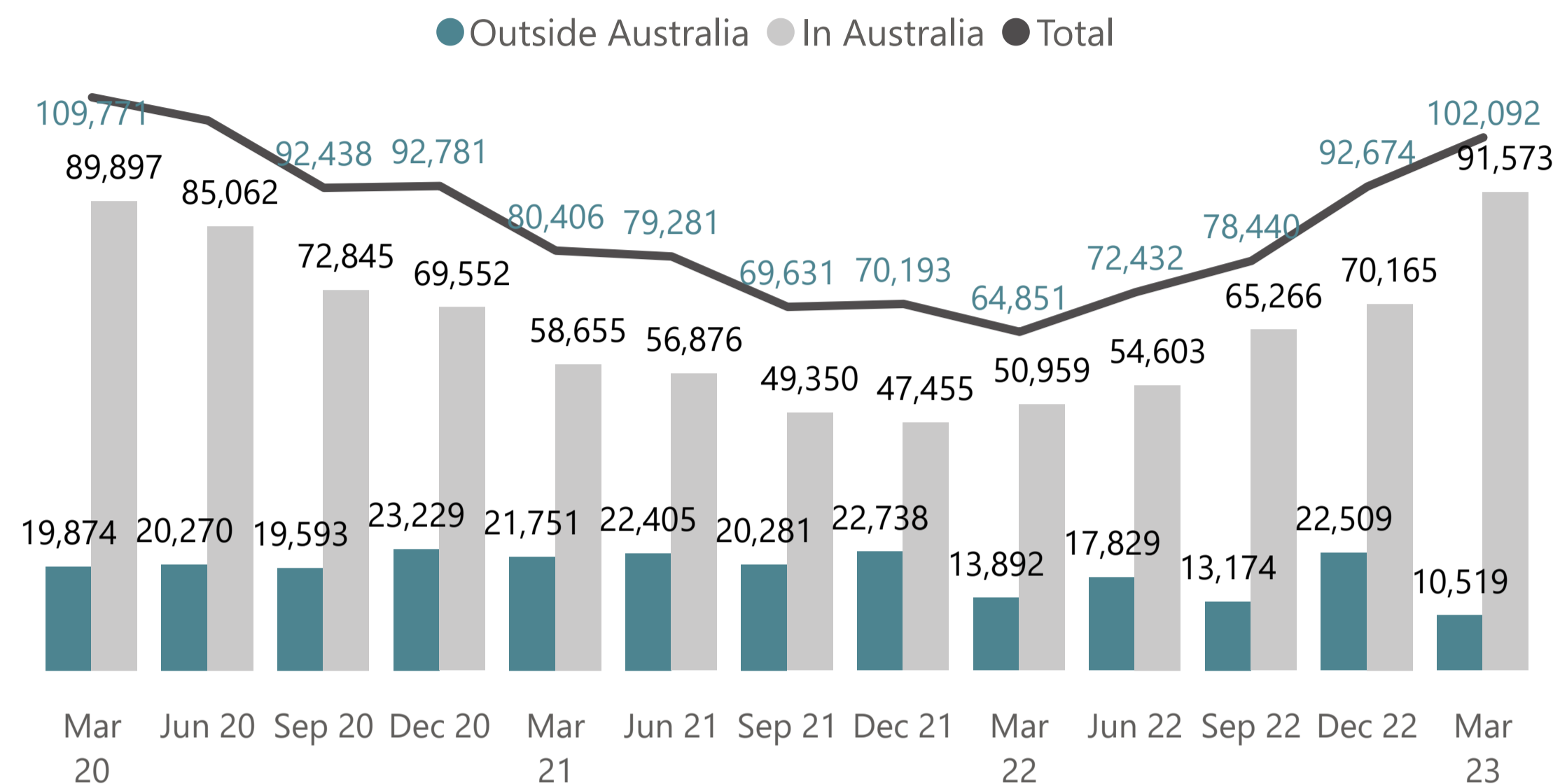

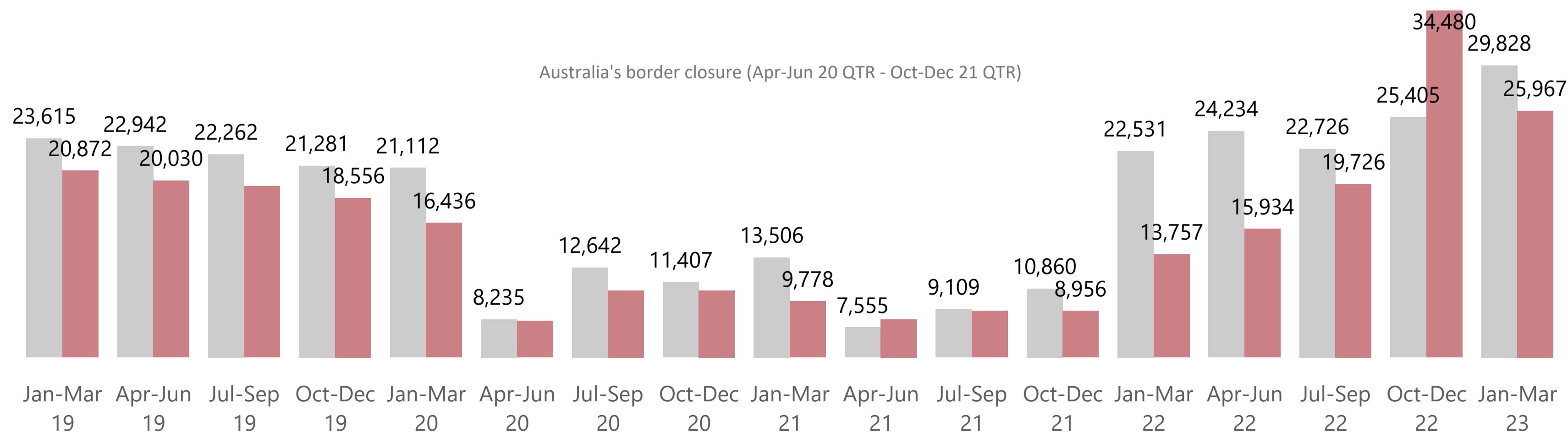
International student arrivals to Queensland in March 2023 of which:
